# Snapshot

**The Marine Corps is the youngest, most junior, and least married of the four military Services.**

- 62% of Marines are 25 or younger
- 21% of Marines are not old enough to legally consume alcohol
- 39% of Marines are LCpl or below (other Services are between 19% - 24%)
- 48.9% of Marines are married (next closest is Navy at 53.9%)
- One Officer per 8.1 Marines (next closest is Navy with one Officer per 5.0 Sailors)

**Marine Corps families are "younger" than those of the other military Services.**


- The average age of Marine Spouses is 28.5 (next closest is Army at 30.9)
- Average age for a married Enlisted Marine 27.4 (average age 30.5 years old for all other services)
- Average Age of a Marine at birth of first child is 23.9 years old



# Marine and Family Status

- The Marine Corps has slightly fewer active duty personnel than family members. There are 200,225 active duty Marines and 207,671 family members: 90,029 spouses, 117,362 children, and 280 parents (TFDW -Dec 2011). This close relationship, 49:51, is unique among the military Services. The active duty to family member ratios of the Army, Navy, and Air Force are all approximately 40% Service members to 60% family members (Data source: DMDC - Dec 2011).



- SNCOs have by far the greatest number of family members of any ranking group.




- When considering the number of active duty Marines and family members, the enlisted ranks account for approximately 85% of the combined population. The ratio of Enlisted Marine and family member to Officer Marine and family member is approximately 5.8:1 (Data source: TFDW - Dec 2011).


- As of Dec 2011, 49% of Marines are married (46.5% of Enlisted Marines and 68.4% of Officers). (Data source: TFDW - Dec 2011). Percentages by rank are:





- From 2008 - 2011, the marital rates for the Marine Corps and Army have steadily increased, while the marital rates for Air Force and Navy have decreased slightly. (Data source: DMDC - Dec 2011)



# Marine and Family Status

- The overall annual divorce rate for the Marine Corps was 3.6% for FY2011. When examining the divorce rate for female Marines, the rate has had an increasing trend since 2006 at 7.2% to the present of 9.5%, an increase of 2.3%.




- For the Marines who were divorced in FY2011, the overall average age was 28 (Broken down: 35 for Officers and 27 for Enlisted). 93% of divorced Marines were from the enlisted ranks (Pvt - LCpl 17%; NCOs 52%; SNCOs 24%) (Data Source: DMDC - FY 2011).

- In FY2011, the divorce rate for Marines with a deployment history was 3.6%, compared to 3.7% for Marines with no deployment history. Since FY2004, the divorce rate for Marines with a deployment history has not been significantly different than the divorce rate for Marines with no deployment history (Data Source: DMDC - FY 2011).

- There was an average of 1.2 children involved in each divorce during FY2011 (Data Source: DMDC - FY 2011).


- 6,163 single Marines have 8,925 dependent children (3.1% of all Marines) (Data source: TFDW - Dec 2011).
- The Marine Corps has 8167 dual military families (TFDW - Dec 2011).
- The average Marine family has 1.13 children (Data source: TFDW -Dec 2011). For purposes of this fact sheet, the Marine family is defined as the number of married Marines with a child, the number of married Marines without a child, and the number of single Marines with a dependent child.
- The largest age group of children as categorized below is the School-Age group (defined as 6 to 12 years) with 40,056 children. 52% of Marine Corps children are 5 years of age or younger, compared to approximately 42% for the other Services. (Data Source: DMDC - Dec 2011).






- The average age of a married Enlisted Marine is 27.4, lower than the other military Services (Data source: TFDW - Dec 2011, DMDC - Dec 2011).



- Of the four Services, the Marine Corps has the youngest average age for spouses, 28.5. (Data source: DMDC - Dec 2011).



- The average age at which a Marine has his or her first child is 23.9 (Data source: DMDC - Dec 2011).




- Of the overall Marine population, 124,582 (62%) of all Marines are age 25 or younger, 41,677 (21%) of Marines are not old enough to legally consume alcohol, and 23,346 (12%) are teenagers (Data Source: TFDW - Dec 2011).


# Service Trends

- The end strength of the active duty Marine Corps has increased since 2001 by 15.91% (from 172,735 to 200,225). Of the remaining three military Services, the Army has experienced an increase of 16.44%, while a decrease was experienced by the Navy of 14.44% and the Air Force of 5.76%. (Data source: DMDC - Dec 2011, TFDW - Dec 2011).

- The Marine Corps is easily the most junior of all the military Services. The Marine Corps has the highest percentage of members who hold the rank of Private, Private First Class, or Lance Corporal (39%) (Data source: TFDW - Dec 2011). The Marine Corps also has the highest percentage of personnel married at rank E-3 or below.







# Service Trends

- On average, Active Duty Officers and Enlisted personnel have served 5.4 years. 55% of the total Active Duty force has served less than 4 years (Data source: TFDW - Dec 2011).



- Officers have served 10.4 years on average, while 59% of all Enlisted personnel have served less than 4 years of active service (Data source: TFDW - Dec 2011).



# Service Trends

- By the end of Dec 2011, 73,645 Marines had deployed to Operation Enduring Freedom or Operation Iraqi Freedom. The Marines who were deployed had 68,094 dependent family members (Data Source: TFDW - Dec 2011).





- The Marine Corps has the lowest percentage of female members of any of the military Services (Data source: DMDC - Dec 2011).





- Minority representation within the Marine Corps (as well as the other three military Services) has increased since 1995 with the exception of African Americans (Data Source: TFDW - Dec 2011). The largest groups of ethnic minorities are:
  - o Hispanic: 12.6% of the Marine Corps (9% in 1995)
  - o Black and African American: 10.1% of the Marine Corps (16% in 1995)
  - o American Indian, Alaskan Native, Asian, Pacific Islander, Orphans of By Race, Declined to Respond: 7.2% of the Marine Corps (4% in 1995)





- The SMCR, IMA, and AR are comprised of 14.6% Officers and 85.4% Enlisted personnel (Data Source: ODSE - Dec 2011).



- The overall average age for SMCR, IMA, AR is 27 (26 is the average age for Enlisted Marines while 37 is the average age for Officers) (Data Source: ODSE - Dec 2011).






# Individual Ready Reserve


- There are 63,000 Individual Ready Reserves (Data Source: ODSE - Dec 2011).
- The Individual Ready Reserves are comprised of 6.6% Officers and 93.4% Enlisted personnel (Data Source: ODSE - Dec 2011).



- The overall average age for Individual Ready Reserve is 26 (26 for Enlisted Marines and 33 for Officers are the average ages) (Data Source: ODSE - Dec 2011).




# Individual Ready Reserve
