**Pre-Separation Brief** covers benefits and entitlements. **Military members must be in UOD.** It is open to all service members and their spouses. \*Bring 3 copies of the DD Form 2648 obtained from the Unit Transition Counselors/Career Retention Specialists.

**TAP Brief** is an employment related workshop. It is open to all service members and their spouses. *IAW ASO 1020.3B. Appropriate civilian wear: Males must wear collared shirt and slacks. Females may wear slacks or skirt. For Both: no shorts, shower shoes, tank top, frayed or cutoff slacks or jeans.*
