College Notes – Academics are foremost in decision making. In-progress classes will NOT be applied to transfer credit evaluation in admission consideration; transfer students for the Athens Campus may not have more than 60 transferable hours

- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA** – Average Freshman GPA 3.91; transfer 3.5+
- **SAT / ACT** – For Spring/Summer/Fall 2022 and beyond, SAT/ACT scores will be required for First Year and Dual Enrollment applicants. Scores must be submitted electronically by the respective testing agency.

- **First Year Applicant** - University System of Georgia Policy, all first-year applicants must complete the Required High School Curriculum (RHSC), which consists of 17 academic units in English (4), Mathematics (4), Science (4), Social Studies (3), and Foreign Language (2). You can get all the essential details in The Georgia Board of Regents high school curriculum guide.
- **Transfer Admission** - Transfer Admission is for students who have completed a minimum of 30 semester hours of transferable credit at a regionally accredited institution. Applicants must apply using the transfer application. More information about the transfer application process can be found on our [Transfer Admission page](#).
- **Non-Traditional Admission** – Nontraditional admission is for Athens-Area students that have been out of high school for five or more years. Applicants must apply using the Nontraditional application. More information about the nontraditional application and admissions criteria can be found on our [Nontraditional Admission page](#).
