College Notes – no separate admission requirements / waivers for military and standardized testing is optional for applicants applying to the fall 2022 semester.

- Application Advice When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-secondary experiences in these sections. At times, some schools welcome you to attach /upload/copy and paste a résumé or CV to explain your non-academic experiences more thoroughly.
- Application Fee \$ may be able to request a waiver for financial need / military contact Veterans Center

- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA** –transfer and freshman minimums are noted; however average GPAs were from 3.7 to 4.0 AND WILL NEED HIGHER for major + may need to complete background courses / required general education at higher GPA
- All applicants whether freshman or transfer must submit the following:
 - Common Application
 - o Common Application School Report (first-year applicants) and transcripts
 - Standardized testing (SAT / ACT)
 - o One teacher or instructor evaluation
- **TRANSFER Success** While you can apply for transfer at any time, the most successful transfers have at least one year of full-time study in general education courses; and, if have less than 32 transferable credits, admission office will focus on HS performance and SAT/ACT
- **SAT / ACT waiver** if you have at least ONE year of full-time study in liberal arts / science courses, then you do not need to submit scores
- SAT / ACT Scores SAT CR 610 710, Math 630 740 OR you may submit three SAT subject tests from Lit / humanities, math or science, and any subject of your choice UNLESS applying to Stern and Engineering Schools then must take math subject test; ACT 28 32 averages only
- JST/DSST/CLEP generally no credit applied
- **SPRING transfer restrictions** no transfers for business and some in other majors see http://www.nyu.edu/admissions/undergraduate-admissions/how-to-apply/all-freshmen-applicants/instructions/additional-program-requirements.html
- STERN SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AND TRANSFER STUDENTS in the past 4 years, Stern has taken less than 1% of transfer applicants. For Marines interested in NYU, unless coming in as a freshman, the POC recommends considering NYU School of Professional Studies
