## College Admission Policy – Transfer

**College Notes – Regional campuses are less crowded, expensive, and convenient. Can start here and transfer to Columbus if remain in good academic standing AND complete 30 hours of credit; Regional Campuses at Lima, Mansfield, Marion or Newark**

- **Application Deadlines** – Please review deadlines on Web site for any changes
- **Application Advice** - When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-secondary experiences in these sections. At times, some schools welcome you to attach /upload/copy and paste a résumé or CV to explain your non-academic experiences more thoroughly.
  - **Freshman** - Veterans are encouraged to include a statement in the "Additional Information" section on the application that details their military service, including years served, rank attained, specialized training, responsibilities, supervisory experience, leadership and other recognitions. Veterans should explain how their military service has prepared them for The Ohio State University. The more information that is included about your military service, the more weight can be placed on your

service. AND you will have an opportunity in the section titled “special circumstances” on the application to include information on any inconsistencies in the academic record.

- **Transfer** – Veterans are encouraged to include a statement in the “Personal Statement” section of the application that details their military service, including years served, rank attained, specialized training, responsibilities, supervisory experience, leadership and other recognitions. Veterans should explain how their military service has prepared them for The Ohio State University. The more information that is included about your military service, the more weight can be placed on your service. AND you will have an opportunity in the section titled “special circumstances” on the application to include information on any inconsistencies in the academic record.

- **Application Fee / Waiver for Veterans** - \$60 waiver for need
- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA** – Transfer average is 3.0+; Freshman 3.2+
- **Essay / Personal Statement**– Freshman essay is required; transfer essay is optional
- **SAT / ACT** – SAT CR 560 – 670 +M 610 – 720 + WR 560 - 660; ACT Composite 27 - 31
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit** - generally means liberal arts / science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by university; online credit is accepted based on guidelines above
- **JST/DSST/CLEP credit** – accepted and applied
- **LORs** – optional for freshman from teacher or counselor
- **Engineering Majors** – can complete your first two years at a regional campus in 14 engineering programs
- **Transfer Student Requirements** - transfer students with less than 30 hours of credit must also meet freshman requirements; Otherwise, complete an application + GPA of 2.0 to begin ; See websites for application deadlines as they vary by campus.

- **Freshman Core Curriculum Requirements** –
  - **English** – 4 years
  - **Math** – 3 years required but 4 years recommended
  - **Social Science** – 2 years but 3 year recommended
  - **Natural Science** – 3 year with significant lab experience
  - **Foreign Language** – 2 years or more of same language
  - **Arts** – 1 year of visual or performing
