## College Admission Policy – Transfer

## College Notes –

- **Application Deadlines** – Please review deadlines on Web site for any changes
- **Application Advice** - When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-secondary experiences in these sections. At times, some schools welcome you to attach /upload/copy and paste a résumé or CV to explain your non-academic experiences more thoroughly.
- **Application Fee** - \$80 may be able to request a waiver for financial need
- **Transfer Status** – any after high school, but held to same standards unless have 60 or more transferable hours; JST credit does not count toward transferable hours
- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA**

- **Personal Statement / Essay** – Freshman and Transfer - Must submit a personal statement + 2 short answer questions; Times New Roman, 12-point font, MLA Format,
- **SAT / ACT** – SAT averages CR 600 – 710 +M 620- 720 + Writing 590 – 700 OR Freshman ACT Composite 28 – 33; TRANSFER SAT AVERAGE – CR+M 1120-1340
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit** - generally means liberal arts / science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by university; Online credit from regionally accredited institutions only
- **JST/DSST/CLEP credit** – JST accepted found here <http://admissions.unc.edu/credit/credit/transfer-credit-for-military-training/>
- **LORs** – at least one academic for both Freshman and Transfer though transfer students it is optional
- **Freshman / transfer candidates – waived if 21-years-old will need** – a unit equates to a semester in college
  - **English** - 4 units
  - **Math** - 4units of college preparatory mathematics (two algebra, one geometry and a higher level mathematics course for which algebra II is a prerequisite)\*
  - **Foreign Language** - at least 2 units of a single foreign language — please note that American Sign Language satisfies this requirement.
  - **Science** - 3 units in science, including at least one unit in a life or biological science and at least one unit in a physical science, and including at least one laboratory course
  - **Social Science** – 2 units of social science, including United States history;
  - **FRESHMAN also need** - Math Requirement - at least one AP Calculus, AP Statistics, Pre-Calculus, Discrete Mathematics, IB Mathematics Level II, Integrated Mathematics IV, Advanced Functions and Modeling, Essentials for College Math
- **Freshman Secondary School Statement** – can be found on the Common Application Web site
- **NOT academically ready** – can transfer from community college, regionally accredited 4-year school or UNC's Part Time Classroom Studies Program info found at <http://admissions.unc.edu/apply/part-time-classroom-studies/> (Part-Time Classroom Studies is designed for local adult students who have been away from a traditional school setting for at least one year and have lived in the area for at least six months); SEE ALSO – UNC CORE <http://unccore.org> for Marines who may wish to take online coursework and prepare for admission (no guarantee of admission)
- **MAJORS** – enroll with less than 60 hours of transferable credit, enrolling into the College of Arts and Sciences; at 60 or more hours able to enter one of the majors / professional schools, which may require additional course work, GPA, and other requirements - <http://admissions.unc.edu/apply/transfer-students/degree-programs/>
- **Transfer student status**
  - **Freshman** – fewer than 30 transferable hours
  - **Sophomore** – 30 – 59 hours of transferable credit
  - **Junior** – 60 or more transferable hours
