- Application Advice When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-

secondary experiences in these sections. At times, some schools welcome you to attach /upload/copy and paste a résumé or CV to explain your non-academic experiences more thoroughly. Marines spend extra time explaining your military career through supplemental application offered by Service To School – see below. Also, in essays address a less than stellar academic record, and why your academic performance will not be a repeat

- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA** Average for transfer 3.0+; Average for freshman 3.5+
- Essay / Personal Statement / Supplemental Questions Essay must be formatted using Times New Roman, 12-point font, MLA Format and both Essay and Supplemental questions can be found on Common Application remember to address prior academic record; focus on what you plan to contribute to Pomona and what you want to get out of attending the College.
- SAT / ACT –Optional
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit** generally means liberal arts / science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by university; online credit is not accepted; courses accepted with a C or better
- JST/DSST/CLEP credit none, though you may be able to seek some through major
- LORs both academic and professional are suggested submit names and contact information through Common Application
- High School / College Prep Courses Freshman Candidates
 - English 4 years with extensive writing / literature
 - Natural Science 3 years with at least two having labs prefer physics or physics ready
 - Foreign Language 3 years in same language
 - \circ Social Science 2 to 3 years
 - Mathematics 4 years with calculus for those interested in STEM fields
