College Notes – College only accepts applications for Fall Semester

- **Application Dates** - Please check admission deadlines for any changes – Applications open for summer / fall on August 1; Spring application opens in early to mid-January
- **Application Advice** - Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-secondary experiences in these sections. **USE: Apply Texas Application** - https://www.applytexas.org/adappc/gen/c_start.WBX
- **Application Fee** - \$75 – can seek fee waiver through Apply Texas Application website
- **Transfer Candidates Must Include:** <https://admissions.utexas.edu/apply/transfer-admission>

- **Essays for Transfer Candidates** – Topic A is required for all candidates AND a second essay from Topic C, D, or E see: for Topics: <https://admissions.utexas.edu/apply/transfer-admission#fndtn-transfer-admission-essay-topics>
- **Résumé** - include previous five years of academic, extracurricular, community and work activities and your honors and awards—including your high school accomplishments if they took place within the last five years. Be sure to incorporate: All your achievements, not just those that didn't fit on the *ApplyTexas* application AND Details about what each activity involved rather than a general description AND The number of hours per week and weeks per year you spent on each activity
- **LORs** – Character and accomplishments / can use Command letters
- **Major Specific Items – Must have prerequisites completed see:** <https://admissions.utexas.edu/explore/prerequisites> AND submit any additional items for your major see: <https://admissions.utexas.edu/explore/academics> - to find out what other items you may need or to see if your major only accepts applicants once a year.
- **Transfer SAT/ACT WAIVER** – after 24 or more hours of credit
- **Transfer GPA Average** – 3.6 – higher for some majors like engineering
- **Freshman SAT / ACT** – SAT averages 1170 – 1410 out of 1600; ACT Composite was 27 - 33; higher scores may be required depending on major
- **Freshman GPA**– average GPA for freshman candidate was 3.9; transfer by major with top majors like business and engineering requiring higher GPA

- **Freshman Applicants Core Requirements** – A freshman is anyone who has graduated high school and never attended a post-secondary institution
 - **English** – 4 years
 - **Math** – 4 years with Algebra 1 and 2, Geometry + a higher math
 - **Science** – 3 years with at least 2 fields of science covered but must have biology or chemistry and science classes must include labs
 - **Social Studies** – 3 years with U.S. History required
 - **Foreign Language** – 2 years same subject
 - **Fine Arts** – 1 year
 - **PE** – 1 year
- **Semester to Quarter Conversion** - 30 semester hours is equivalent to 45 quarter hours
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit** - generally means liberal arts/ science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by the university; Accepted credit is subject to specific rules – <https://admissions.utexas.edu/apply/transfer-resources>
