College Notes – Presidential Program has limited slots each year; not every Marine can use

- **Admission Deadlines** - Please check Web site for any changes – there are no early admission opportunities (Fall and Spring only)

- **Application Advice** - When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, HS experiences, résumé
- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA** – required 3.0 high school; require higher depending on major
- **Presidential Admission Program**
 - **GPA / SAT / ACT rules** – 60+ transferable hours waive GPA / ACT / SAT
 - **Limited number of slots** - competitive process; must meet all requirements as laid out above
 - **Major restrictions** – cannot major in Athletic Training, Dance, English ADT option, Kinesiology- Exercise generalist (ADT Option); Liberal Studies – Education Generalist (ADT Option), Music, NURSING, Psychology – Applied (ADT Option); Social Work, Theatre Arts - performance
- **Personal Statement / Essay** – part of freshman or traditional transfer process
- **SAT and ACT** – SAT CR + Math Composite score of 1100 - 1220 out of 1600 is considered competitive; ACT Composite 22-27 out of 37 (*all tests waived until 2023 FALL due to COVID-19)
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit**- generally means liberal arts / science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by university - **JST/DSST/CLEP credit** – Some accepted – will do a review of credit after admission; Online Credit accepted from a regionally accredited program; but limitations on amount and transfer equivalencies

- **For admission – Traditional Freshman – Veterans are NOT exempt - IMPACTION RULES**
normally, veterans/military are exempt from impaction rules and considered Inside applicants; however, service members will still need to meet academic and other criteria Review Impaction rules If not exempt from impaction rules <http://arweb.sdsu.edu/es/advising/impaction.html>
 - Impaction means - the campus expects more qualified applicants than available spots for which there is adequate state funding
 - Inside / Outside Area – essentially all Cal State System schools are defined an area of admission. To be an Inside Applicant, you need to have attended a school within the SDSU defined parameters. If not, you are an Outside Applicant and subject to Impaction rules
 - Review SDSU Admission Requirements based on Admission Group – meet or exceed requirements
 - Review Quantifiable Eligibility Index – Formula for determining whether candidate has sufficient scores to apply - based on whether Marine is considered an inside or outside area candidate

- **California State Golden Four** – **see handout** – all candidates must meet this requirement
- SDSU Application through CSUMentor / Supplemental Application – fill out application; you will receive within 2 weeks a RedID and instructions on creating your Supplemental application. You will be required to provide documentation and other items in the Supplemental Application
