- **Application Deadlines** – One application deadline a year - <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/apply-online/> and must create a **TAP Account** submit courses for review by POC at <https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu/students>
- **Application Advice** - When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-

secondary experiences in these sections. See <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/apply-online/>

- **VETERANS** make sure to articulate what you've learned from your experience serving our country; indicate on Application intent to file JST – which every Marine should do!
- **Application Update** Priority deadline is January 31st. Must provide final grades from the previous term and list all courses in progress or planned for the term before you expect to enroll. Some programs require supplemental materials that you must submit directly to the department: [Supplemental Applications | UCLA Undergraduate Admission](#)
- **Application Rules** – Send official transcripts **AFTER ADMISSION** – See website for Veteran info as well as transcript, supplemental info, and help when need to fix an issue on a submitted application <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/apply-online/>
- **Application Fee / Waiver for Veterans** – \$70 per application; same application for all UC campuses, Section 8 will ask if you want to apply for fee waiver. Click on option; Income verification screens will appear – family size and total income for family that size – fill in blanks with SGT at 20k; CPL 18k; and LCPL 16k – click okay. Then, move onto final submission of application.
- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA** – UCLA's Freshman Profile: <https://admission.ucla.edu/apply/freshman/freshman-profile> ; UCLA's Transfer Profile: <https://admission.ucla.edu/apply/transfer/transfer-profile>
- **Personal Insight Questions** – UCLA requires short answer responses as a Transfer one required question and an additional three responses; Freshman require four out of eight questions required; See <http://www.admission.ucla.edu/prospect/PerStmt.htm>
 - **Special Instructions for Veterans** – UCLA suggests that within the Personal Insight Questions respond to the following ideas: 1) Describe how your military service has been instrumental in developing your educational plans; 2) Indicate if you are entitled to educational benefits as a result of your own military service to the service connected death or disability of a parent or spouse; 3) Indicate if you are affiliated with the military such as, but not limited to, the spouse or dependent of someone who is on active duty or a current participant in an ROTC-type program
 - **Emphasize leadership, duty, commitment through specific examples** – illustrate with one strong example rather than a litany of examples
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit** - US Colleges or universities must be regionally accredited in order for UCLA to award any credit for coursework completed; subject to strict review by university; online credit is accepted based strict review; C or better in each course: [Transferring Credits | UCLA Undergraduate Admission](#)
- **JST**– little if any applied
- **UC System A-G Courses from High School or College** – regardless of status, all applicants must have completed the A-G curriculum; includes 15 year long HS or semester long college courses; Freshman see: [Freshman Requirements | UCLA Undergraduate Admission](#)
- **Transfer Student Minimum Requirements** -
 - UC Seven Course Pattern + 60 semester/90 quarter units of UC transferable credit + minimum 3.2 GPA + required major preparation courses

- **Major Preparation Courses Transfer Students**– Each major requires specific coursework to be completed prior to Transfer. This is in addition to the minimum requirements: See –UCLA Transfer Admission Guide: <https://admission.ucla.edu/downloads>
- **SPECIAL TRANSFER NOTE:** Even one college level course after high school precludes an applicant from applying until the applicant has 60 transferable credit hours; applies to all UC schools
