College Notes – The Veterans Application is intended for U.S. military veterans. Applicants wishing to transfer from U.S. military academies are encouraged to apply as transfer students using the Common App. Individuals who have previously earned a bachelor’s degree are not eligible to apply.

 - Application is available starting in October, with a deadline of March 1 for proposed enrollment in the following fall semester. Once applications are complete, including all required materials, applicants will be notified of decisions on a rolling basis. For applications completed by February 15, applicants can expect a decision within four weeks. Those completing after February 15 will be notified in six to eight weeks or by mid-May at the latest.
- **Application Requirements** - If you have recent college courses, they prefer at least one academic recommendation from a professor or other instructor. They also welcome recommendations from military commanding officers or supervisors, civilian employers, or community leaders who can speak to your experience and talents.

- **Optional / Supplemental Materials** - A short video introduction may be submitted via your Brown Applicant Portal. Sharing a two-minute personal video is a helpful way to show us more about yourself, in your voice, beyond the information you provided in your application, Joint Services Transcript and/or S2S VetLink Addendum, and Resume.
- **Transfer Student Information** - transferable college credits will receive an estimated semester level of entry with your offer of admission letter. After consulting with advisors and starting your studies at Brown, you may choose whether to transfer eligible credits or decline them in order to have more time to complete their academic goals. Transfer credit eligibility is determined by academic deans in The College. ***Online courses, summer courses, and most military training courses are generally not eligible for transfer credit.*** However, they will consider this academic work and training as part of the admission process.
- **Application Advice** – You are required to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), a previous federal income tax return (2020 tax return for 2022 entry), and a Certificate of Eligibility from the VA to the [Office of Financial Aid](#) by the March 1 deadline. Admitted students who have submitted all required documents will receive their financial aid package along with their offer of admission.
