- **Application Dates** - Please check admission deadlines for any changes
- **Application Advice** - When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-

secondary experiences in these sections. At times, some schools welcome you to attach /upload/copy and paste a résumé or CV to explain your non-academic experiences more thoroughly.

- **Application Fee** - \$75 may be able to request a waiver for financial need / military contact Veterans Center or Can qualify for application waiver per Georgetown requirements – per NACAC requirements - <https://uadmissions.georgetown.edu/first-year/fee-waiver>
- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA** –transfer and freshman minimums are noted; however average GPAs were from 3.0 to 4.0 AND WILL NEED HIGHER for major + may need to complete background courses / required general education at higher GPA
- **SAT / ACT** - Old SAT – CR 620-730; M 630-740; New SAT (2016) – CR+M 1400+ / No SAT subject tests required; ACT 30+
- **JST/DSST/CLEP** – no DSST or CLEP; JST if taken at all must be reviewed after admission
- **Additional documents** - include Secondary School Report; Teacher’s Report; and mid-year report – suggest requesting waiver
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit** - generally means liberal arts/ science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by the university; Accepted credit is subject to specific rules
- **Transfer Student Status** - Need at least 12 TRANSFERABLE CREDITS – JST credit does not count toward number needed; credit must be from a traditional program, regionally accredited 2 or 4-year institution; SOME online credit may apply
- **SAT/ACT Waiver** - SAT for transfer students waived only if out of high school five years or longer but must have 12+ credits or considered a freshman transfer and MUST have an SAT or SAT – however, a strong ACT or SAT may assist in overcoming a mediocre academic record; necessary scores listed above
- **Major information:**
 - **Math or Science** – need at least 4 years of math through calculus and 3 years of science with labs from either high school or college transfer courses
 - **Nursing** – 3 years math + one year biology and 1 year chemistry with labs
 - **Business** – 3 years math through advanced Algebra and Trigonometry – need to be ready for calculus + computer science course focused on programming
 - **Language or Foreign Service** – extensive study of modern foreign language or Latin (DLI Marines can satisfy this component, but must also bring strong high school academic record or college record (general education courses preferred) + good SAT or ACT scores
 - **Note:** qualifying for admission to Georgetown does not mean that Marine is qualified for admission to specific area of study – each major has additional requirements
- **Dean’s Report** - Transfer students are required to get a Dean’s report from current institution and a secondary school report
