- Application Advice When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-

secondary experiences in these sections. At times, some schools welcome you to attach /upload/copy and paste a résumé or CV to explain your non-academic experiences more thoroughly. Applying for early decision requires applicant to withdraw all other applications if admitted.

 - Freshman Applications have a personal statement + optional Williams Writing Supplement
 - Transfer Applications have a personal statement + optional <u>Williams Writing Supplement</u>
- SAT / ACT CR 670 780 + M 660 770 + optional W 670 780 ACT Composite 31 34
- Transferable Credit / Online Credit generally means liberal arts / science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by college; online credit is NOT accepted based on guidelines above, except for courses that were online because of the Covid-19 pandemic; JST/DSST/CLEP credit Not accepted
- LORs
 - **Freshman** require two teacher recommendations and a counselor recommendation (counselor recommendation can be waived for veteran applicants)
 - Transfer require two instructor evaluations, if possible
- **Transfer Student Requirements** recommend returning to traditional community college for a semester or two to prove academic ability
 - Common Application or Coalition Application transfer students must use one or the other
 - Transfer College Report can find this form on the application Web sites
- Senior Grade Report from high school showing progress in last semester of high school
