College Notes – Transfer Admission for Spring is about 35 students; UVA recommends applying for Fall Admission

- **Application Deadlines** – Please review deadlines on Web site for any changes
- **Application Advice** - When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-secondary experiences in these sections. At times, some schools welcome you to attach /upload/copy and paste a résumé or CV to explain your non-academic experiences more thoroughly. See: www.commapp.org
 - **Spring Applications for Transfer** – only for the College of Arts & Sciences, Architectural History or Urban and Environmental Planning

- **Business Majors** – with 24 hours apply as to College of Arts and Sciences as a Pre-Commerce major; if more than 24 hours of transferable, applicable credit, may apply to School of Commerce
- **Guaranteed Transfer through Virginia Community College** – Fall transfer only
- **Other Restrictions** - School of Engineering and Applied Science will accept applicants who are seeking a second undergraduate degree; Students who have completed three or more years of study at another four-year institution ARE NOT eligible for transfer admission to the College of Arts and Sciences.
- **Application Fee / Waiver for Veterans** -
- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA** –for transfer is 3.0 minimum; Average is 3.5; for freshman, but may need higher depending on major + may need to complete background courses / required general education at higher GPA
- **Essay / Personal Statement**– Must submit a personal statement; Essay must be formatted using Times New Roman, 12-point font, MLA Format with double-spaced paragraphs;
- **SAT / ACT** – CR 620-720 +M 630 – 740 + WR 620 - 720; ACT Composite 27 – 31; SAT and ACT are waived for transfer students who have been out of high school for five years or more. BUT students applying to the School of Commerce AND students applying through Virginia’s guaranteed admission / community college program MUST submit ACT or SAT scores regardless of how old the candidate is or how long the candidate has been out of school.
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit** - generally means liberal arts / science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by university; Credit is evaluated for transfer by the Dean of the appropriate school; C or better;
- **JST/DSST/CLEP credit** – JST if applied will be reviewed after admission; CLEP accepted; DSST tests are not accepted
- **LORs** – Transfer students may be able to submit a professional letter; prefer academic letters
- **Transfer Student Requirements** - **Completed at least one full year of college study prior to entering UVA prior to the October Deadline.** Before applying to UVA, most successful candidates have all required / prerequisite coursework completed and a 3.0 or higher GPA. Note: It is not necessary to have all of the coursework completed in order to apply to UVA. Review required courses by UVA School or College

- **Freshman Course Work** – UVA requires freshman to complete a rigorous course of study in high school including English, math, social studies, and science with lab courses. UVA expects the rigor of the coursework to reflect a high level of academic achievement with a 3.8 or higher GPA.
- **Senior Grade Report** – from high school showing progress in last semester of high school
