### College Admission Policy – Transfer

\*All of the above except the personal statement and the transcripts are waived for Veterans and currently serving applicants. Also there is no minimum GPA to apply or even be admitted whether you're a military-connected student or not.

## College Notes – Special application / application deadline privileges for military

- **Military Required Application** –MUST USE THE MILITARY APPLICATION FOUND AT <http://admissions.syr.edu/wp-content/uploads/2016/03/MilVetApp-FINAL-23-MAR-2016-1141hrs-version.pdf> AND FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS; Submit by EMAIL to [applyvet@syr.edu](mailto:applyvet@syr.edu)
- **Application Advice** - When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-secondary experiences in these sections. At times, some schools welcome you to attach /upload/copy and paste a résumé or CV to explain your non-academic experiences more thoroughly.
- **Common Application** – the school accept the Common Application but also have a free application for Veterans or those currently serving. Family members must use the Common Application to apply.
- **\*Application Deadlines** – see <http://admissions.syr.edu/apply/deadlinesguidance/>; for Veterans there is no application deadline as applications are reviewed on a rolling basis; Syracuse recommends getting an application in at least six weeks prior to the beginning of a semester; however, Applicants should consider simply following the guidelines set because of limited space. Proof of military service (preferably Member Copy 4 of the applicant's DD214) is required of military applicants. **These deadlines apply only to military family members or non-military connected applicants.**
- **GPA minimum does not equate to competitive GPA** –for transfer is minimum; for freshman, but may need higher depending on major + may need to complete background courses / required general education at higher GPA
- **Military Essay / Personal Statement**– Must submit a personal statement Or respond to one of the prompts found on page 4 of the application; Essay must be formatted using Times New Roman, 12-point font, MLA Format with double-spaced paragraphs; 250 – 500 word essay that addresses the reasons for applying to Syracuse and the objectives hope to achieve **OR** can select from the list found on page 4 of the military application
- **SAT / ACT** – Marines submitting old SAT Exam require CR+M+WR; Marines taking new SAT CR+M only; Averages are 1070-1280; ACT Composite 24 -29
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit** - generally means liberal arts / science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by university; online credit is accepted based on guidelines above
- **JST/DSST/CLEP credit** – will review and apply
- **LORs MILITARY** – may require letters to bolster admission application; POC suggests submitting or having at ready

- **Application Fee Waiver for Veterans** - <http://veterans.syr.edu/prospective/veterans/>
- **Apply as a Transfer IF** - Have completed at least 12 credit hours. Apply as a transfer
- **Apply as a Freshman IF** - will have less than 12 credits when you plan to enroll
- **High School / College Prep Courses** – **FRESHMAN CANDIDATES** four years of each English, science, social studies, and mathematics (through geometry and intermediate algebra), and minimum of three years of a foreign language

- **Senior Grade Report** – from high school showing progress in last semester of high school; waiver for military
- **Additional Major Requirements** – see <http://admissions.svr.edu/apply/collegespecificrequirements/>
  - College of Engineering and Computer Science – 4 years math including pre-calculus and/or calculus; laboratory science including physics; and for military may waive the LOR from a science/math instructor
  - College of Visual and Performing Arts – may require auditions
  - School of Architecture – portfolio required
