College Notes – First year admission either to Emory College or Oxford College. As third year students, come together on the Atlanta Campus and complete major coursework at the Emory College of Arts and Sciences, Goizueta School of Business or the School of Nursing. Entrance requirements are the same. One application can apply to one or both campuses. Can add one campus or other or make corrections after application submitted by sending an email to admission@emory.edu

- **Application Advice** - When filling out the Application for Admission, please complete sections which do not seem directly relevant to your personal, academic, and military experiences to the best of your ability. For example, the application asks about your extracurricular activities, awards, and honors. Veteran applicants should feel free to include military experiences and distinctions, high school experiences, and any other post-

secondary experiences in these sections. At times, some schools welcome you to attach /upload/copy and paste a résumé or CV to explain your non-academic experiences more thoroughly.

- **Application Fee / Waiver for Veterans** - \$75. Waived for veterans and applicants with financial need; forms in Common and Coalition Apps
- **GPA of middle 50% of Fall 2021 admitted students** –First Year Middle 50% GPA 3.67 – 3.98; Transfer Middle 50% GPA 3.5-3.7
- **Essay / Personal Statement**–Times New Roman, 12-point font, MLA Format –
 - **Freshman** – Personal Statement + Emory writing section
 - **Transfer** – Personal Statement + Emory writing section
- **SAT / ACT (Optional)** – No more than 3 years old;
 - **SAT** - CR 710-770 +M 740-780
 - **ACT Composite** - 33-35
- **Transferable Credit / Online Credit** - generally means liberal arts / science / math credit (e.g. general education) from a regionally accredited 2-year or 4-year, traditional institution; subject to strict review by university; **JST/DSST/CLEP credit** – none
- **Letters Of Recommendation** –
 - **Freshman** – 2 academic letters
 - **Transfer** – 1 faculty recommendation / out of school for a year or more can use professional letter
- **Transfer Student Requirements** -
 - **Transfer Status** - completed one year of full-time study in a degree seeking program or starting second semester of full-time student and has completed or will have completed 28 hours of coursework at time of transfer
 - **Supplemental Materials** – résumé or other items that feel are necessary and information is not covered elsewhere in application; attach as PDF and include full name, birth date, student ID #
- **Secondary School Report / College Official Report / Mid-year Academic Report** – all forms are found in either the Common or Coalition Applications
- **High School / College Prep Courses – Freshman Candidates** – suggest taking most rigorous courses in high school and maintaining a unweighted B+ / A average
- **Interviews** – freshman only optional with Alumni only and in select cities
